


Ticketmaster-NBA Account Set Up: NBA Guests

- 1. Visit Ticketmaster at: <u>https://am.ticketmaster.com/nba</u> or scan the QR code below to set up "NBA AccountManager" to access all NBA All-Star 24 tickets.
- 2. Register by clicking the "Sign In" button in the top right corner of the screen. If you do not have a Ticketmaster account, click "Sign Up Here" on the bottom left of the screen.
- **3. IMPORTANT:** You must ensure that your Ticketmaster account email is the same email address as the email used to purchase or acquire NBA All-Star event tickets. This is how all tickets will be delivered.


Managing Your Tickets



Accepting Tickets

You will receive a notification email once your tickets have been sent.

NOTE: You will receive a separate email for each ticketed event (e.g., State Farm All-Star Saturday Night and 73rd NBA All-Star Game ticket transfer email would be sent as 2 emails).




You can either click "Accept Tickets" in each email you receive OR log into <u>NBA AccountManager</u> where you will be able to accept all tickets in one place.

It is recommended that you save all tickets to your digital wallet to ensure ease of access.




Transferring Tickets

- Select the event and then click "Transfer" to initiate the transaction
- Select the tickets you wish to transfer and then fill out the email address and information as requested
- Tickets can be transferred <u>on</u> to other members of your group if you have multiple tickets

Access Tickets through the NBA Events App



- Download the <u>NBA EVENTS app</u> from the <u>Apple</u> or <u>Google Play</u> stores
- From the <u>NBA Events app</u>, click on the ticket icon on the lower right side of the homepage.
- Choose "NBA Guest Tickets" and then click on "View Your Tickets."
- You will be prompted to link your NBA app with your NBA Account Manager TM account.
- Add ticket(s) to your mobile wallet (Apple/Google) to ensure barcodes will activate if Wi-Fi is not available at the venue.






Accessing Mobile Tickets through Account Manager



- Tickets are also readily available within <u>NBA Account Manager</u> at any time.
- To access tickets via NBA Account Manager, visit the site from your mobile device.
- Select the event and then the seat you are using. The barcode will populate as shown in the screenshot below.
- Add the ticket(s) to your mobile wallet (Apple/Google) on your smartphone to ensure barcodes will
 activate if Wi-Fi is not available at the venue.
- Once a ticket is scanned at the venue, it CANNOT be scanned again.





Bag Policy and Prohibited items

Prohibited items below apply for all venues for NBA All-Star events in Indianapolis.



PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items, as well as any other items deemed dangerous, inappropriate, or disruptive, are prohibited and may be confiscated. Refusal to surrender these items may result in revocation of access to the venue.

WEAPONS & DANGEROUS ITEMS

Weapons of any sort including, but not limited to, firearms and knives of any size are prohibited. Any items deemed by the venue, in its discretion, to be dangerous are also prohibited.

LARGE BAGS

Bags and backpacks larger than 14 x 14 x 6 inches in size are prohibited. All hard-sided bags are prohibited.

LARGE FLAGS, BANNERS & SIGNS

Attendees are not permitted to use or wave any flags, banners, signs, or other items that are more than 11 x 17 inches in size.

ITEMS AFFIXED TO POLES

No flags, banners, or signs of any size may be affixed to any pole or stick made of wood, metal, plastic, or any other hard material.



Prohibited Items Continued...

OFFENSIVE SIGNS AND CLOTHING

Clothing, garments, and signs (including, but not limited to, flyers, handouts, and pamphlets) that contain or display explicit language, profanity, or derogatory characterization toward any person or category/group of persons are prohibited. Obscene or indecent messaging on clothing, garments, or signs is also prohibited. All messaging on otherwise permissible signs must be related to the event.

<u>DRONES</u>

Drones of any kind, regardless of size, are prohibited in the venue and the immediately surrounding area.

ITEMS AFFIXED TO POLES

No flags, banners, or signs of any size may be affixed to any pole or stick made of wood, metal, plastic, or any other hard material.
